Happy Easter everyone!! May the risen Christ live always in your hearts!!

Please remember that every day we will be praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet at 3:00p.m. as we continue with the Novena that we started on Good Friday. If you cannot come to St. Sylvester's Church to pray it you can pray it privately in your home. The Novena will end on Divine Mercy Sunday which is April 16th. In these challenging times it is very important to remember the mercy of God and invoke that merciful love upon the whole world.

On Saturday of this week at the 5:00p.m. Mass five of our school children will be receiving their First Holy Communion. They are prepared and excited for this important day. On Friday, April 14th I will practice with them at 9:00a.m. so that they will know what they are to do when they receive our Blessed Lord in Holy Communion. Congratulations to these children and to their parents!

Our Mass schedule this week will be unaltered and since we will be celebrating the Octave of Easter until next Sunday it is as if the Easter mystery is played out every day and hopefully you will come and participate in our daily Masses as your schedule permits. We will also have the all-day adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Wednesday from 8:00a.m. to 6:00p.m. Perhaps you will be able to stop in for a visit to our Lord.

Next Sunday as we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday we will have a holy hour from 3:00p.m. to 4:00p.m. with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and prayers to commemorate the mercy of God. This will take place at the church of St. Sylvester and everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend.

In the book JESUS, OUR EUCHARISTIC LOVE by Fr. Stefano Manelli we read the following: "The best example of participation at the Holy Sacrifice is given us at the foot of the Cross by the most Blessed Virgin Mary, St. John the Evangelist and St. Mary Magdalene with the pious women. To assist at Mass is very much like being at Calvary. The Servant of God, Pope John Paul II in a discourse to youth, made this simple, moving statement: 'to go to Mass means to go to Calvary to meet Him, our Redeemer.' A meeting of love and sorrow with Jesus Crucified----this is participation at Holy Mass."
