Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Monday, June 27<sup>th</sup> after the 8:30 a.m. Mass I'll be heading down to Greenville, S.Carolina to visit one of my sisters and to bless her new house. I'll be gone until Thursday evening, June 30<sup>th</sup>. And so there will not be Mass on June 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, or 30<sup>th</sup>. On Friday, July 1<sup>st</sup> I will have Mass at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's with a Holy Hour of Reparation to follow from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. We'll pray the Stations of the Cross and the chaplet of Divine Mercy followed by adoration and Benediction. I hope you will join us. We usually do the Holy Hour at 3:00 p.m. on the First Friday out at St. John's but I have to take someone to the airport on Friday afternoon and so we'll have the Holy Hour after the 8:30 a.m. Mass instead this time. On Saturday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> we'll have the 8:30 a.m. Latin Mass and fulfil Our Lady's request at Fatima to make reparation on the First Saturday of five consecutive months. To fulfil the request we need to go to confession, receive Holy Communion and pray five mysteries of the Holy Rosary. We also have to spend about 15 or 20 minutes in the company of Our Lady while meditating on one or more of the rosary mysteries. Please join us if you are able.

I notice that some people are coming to Mass but not dressed for Church. I am glad that they are at Mass but since we are attending a Sacrifice the clothing we wear should reflect our reverence for the Mystery unfolding on the altar. Please consider others when deciding what to wear. Be modest. Try not to draw attention to yourself by wearing clothes that reveal too much skin. Every summer we have this same issue and it is certainly not one that I relish talking about!! But, as the Pastor I feel I need to say something when I see things that aren't right. May Our Lady of Fatima guide us always to be truly modest and to wear clothing that truly covers our bodies.
