Dear Friends of God,

We remember this weekend 9/11 and the tragic attack on the World Trade Center Towers resulting in a terrible loss of life and the destruction that has taken years from which to recover. I am reminded of the horrible suffering now being experienced also in Ukraine with the ongoing war being waged by Russia. Let us pray for peace in the hearts of all humankind and the cessation of such violence being perpetrated against other human beings. We continue as well to pray to end the violence against the unborn. As Mother Teresa so famously said: "There will not be peace until abortion is overcome". We have much to pray about in our times.

We have several initiatives starting up this week. On Monday, September 12th, Feast of the Holy Name of Mary we will have Mass at 5:30 p.m. at St. Sylvester Church with a Bible Study to follow. We'll also enjoy a light reception in the Church basement. The Bible Study will take a look at the upcoming readings for the Sunday Liturgy using the resources of the St. Paul Center for Biblical Studies directed by Dr. Scott Hahn. It might help prepare us for hearing the Word of God from Sunday to Sunday. All are welcome.

The other initiative that will be starting up will be my visits to the second graders in the school as I prepare them for their first confession and first Communion. I'll be doing that on Wednesdays at 8:30 a.m. in the school building starting this coming Wednesday. I think there will be six children participating.

I'll also be teaching on Tuesday afternoons in the Church basement at 4:30 p.m. This will be for those children of catechetical age who do not attend our parish school but instead are enrolled in the public school. There are three currently attending. Also, at St. John's Eileen Ackermann is also teaching catechism before the 10:30 a.m. Sunday Mass starting this Sunday, September 11th. And also on Tuesday evenings I am teaching three young people and preparing them for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation. They are a special case because they are teenagers and one is actually 22 years of age. On Thursday evening at 7:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester church basement I am also preparing other children for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Currently there are four participants in the class. Bishop has allowed those in the fifth grade and up to prepare for this Sacrament.

We have a couple of beautiful Liturgical Feasts this week: The Triumph of the Cross on September 14<sup>th</sup> and the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows on September 15<sup>th</sup>. On Wednesday we will have the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament all day as usual and then at 6:30 p.m. we'll celebrate the Feast of the Triumph of the Cross. And on Thursday, September 15<sup>th</sup> we'll have a 9:00 a.m. Mass at St. John's in Miltonsburg preceded by an hour of Eucharistic adoration and also Mass in the evening of September 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. at St. Sylvester's. This will be sung Latin traditional Mass. The Confirmation Class also scheduled on Thursday evening will be invited to attend the Latin Traditional Mass to learn a little about our Catholic worship in the way it was carried out for hundreds of years. The 6:30 p.m. Mass will conclude around 7:30 p.m.
