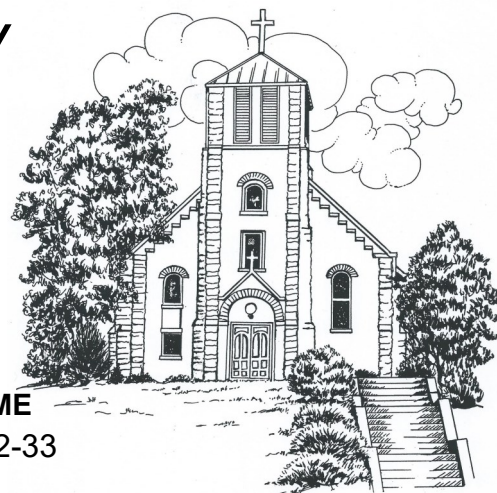
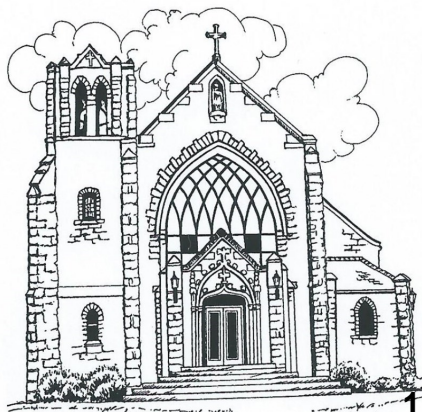

During this week the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary occurs on Tuesday, August 15th. The Assumption is one of our Holy Days of Obligation. It is required that all Catholics attend the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on that great Feast. Mary's assumption into heaven bodily is one of the dogmas of the faith having been believed for many centuries. Our Mass schedule is as follows:

Monday, August 14th at 5:30 p.m. at St. Sylvester's for Vigil

Tuesday, August 15th at 9:00 a.m. at St. John the Baptist

Tuesday, August 15th at 7:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's.

The rest of the week should be as normal regarding the daily Mass schedule. On Wednesday our adoration will also be as usual as well. Thank you to all those who make it to daily Mass and to the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Wednesdays. Sometimes I am offering the Holy Sacrifice alone in the Church especially at St. Sylvester's on Fridays. This has happened more than once unfortunately. Please come to pray at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass during the week as often as possible. It is actually a great consolation when there are people to assist at the Mass. And it can be quite discouraging when no one shows up. What must Our Divine Lord feel who is offering Himself in an unbloody manner on the holy altar? This indifference must truly wound His most Sacred Heart. That is one of the reasons why the First Fridays are important as a time of making reparation.

May the Lord grant to each of us a deepening of the virtue of faith that we might see and appreciate the divine gifts that are being offered especially through the sacraments.
