This week on Wednesday we begin the season of Lent. Our Masses on Ash Wednesday are as follows:

8:30 a.m. School Mass followed by exposition of the Blessed Sacrament

12:00 noon Mass at St. John the Baptist Church

7:00 p.m. Mass at St. Sylvester's

(at 6:00 p.m. the all - day adoration ends with Benediction)

On Friday of this week (February 24th) the school Mass will be at 8:30 a.m. followed by Stations of the Cross and then confessions for the 5th through 8th graders.

In the evening on Friday there will be the annual Knights of Columbus Fish Fry beginning at 4:30 p.m. and Stations of the Cross will follow at St. Sylvester's at 6:00 p.m. Every Friday through Lent the Stations of the Cross will be prayed at 6:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's.

PARISH MISSION

Every year I invite someone to give the communities of St. Sylvester and St. John's a PARISH MISSION. This year the PARISH MISSION will occur from Saturday evening until Tuesday evening (Feb. 25th through Feb. 28th). Here is the schedule:

On Saturday and Sunday Feb. 25th and 26th Father John Eudes from the Canons of the Holy Cross in Carrolton, Ohio will offer the weekend Masses and preach. He will also be available for confessions at the usual times. Father Eudes is originally from Michigan and will be with us as the priest giving the MISSION.

The first MISSION talk will be on Sunday evening at 6:00 p.m. with confessions available afterwards. And then on Monday, Feb. 27th Father Eudes will offer Mass at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's and then give the MISSION talk in the evening at 6:00 p.m. and offer confessions afterwards. Then, finally on Tuesday, Feb. 28th Father Eudes will be at St. John's at 9:00 a.m. for the Mass and again at St. Sylvester's in the evening at 6:00 p.m. for the final MISSION talk and confessions.

PARISH MISSIONS help to renew the faith of the parishioners and so during Lent especially it is a good idea to participate in such a MISSION. The MISSION offers the opportunity to make a good confession as well. Confessions will be held throughout the time of the MISSION as noted above.

The talks during the MISSION this year will be on 1.) mental prayer, 2.) Lectio Divino, 3.) the hidden world of the angels.

Let us pray for each other that the graces the Lord wants to give us during this holy season of Lent will not be rejected. God bless and keep you in His love.
