

Dear Parishioners,

I hope you are able to enjoy the holiday weekend with friends and family.

I would like to congratulate our eight grade students who will be graduating and moving on to High School. Our prayers go with you as you begin this new chapter of your lives.

Jesus tells us in the Gospel of Saint John: "I have told you this while I am with you. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you (John 14:26)."

Who, or what, is this Holy Spirit? What does He do? The Spirit that Jesus sends us is not some ghost of a person long dead. He is not part of the Father or part of the Son, but a distinct Divine Person in the life of the Trinity.

Sometimes we speak of the Spirit in a euphemistic sense to describe a sensation or a feeling. We can also speak of the Holy Spirit euphemistically to describe the changes happening in the world or the Church. Both of these erroneously miss the mark. Furthermore, the Holy Spirit (contrary to the teaching and worship of the Pentecostals) does not primarily operate as a distributer of the charismatic gifts – prophesy, tongues, etc. – which are of their nature extraordinary and therefore rare. So, what does the Spirit do? Jesus teaches us in John 16:13 hen he says "But when He the, Spirit of truth, shall come, He will guide you into all the truth." So this is the main mission and working of the Holy Spirit: to guide us in the truth, the truth of knowing and living in the Gospel of Jesus Christ and being faithful to the truths of the faith God we have learned from the Church. The gifts of the Spirit - wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, and the fear of the Lord – are given to us to help confirm us and guide us in this truth.

Cooperating with the Spirit of God, let us live the life that Jesus entrusted to us before he ascended to His Father in Heaven. He ascends to His glory, but he does not leave us or His Church bereft of guidance. So let us pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit, and that He may inspire us and the leaders of our Church to greater fidelity to the truth they have received from God.
