

As you know I have been trying to encourage you to come as often as possible to daily Mass. We can learn many things from the lives of the saints and their devotion to the daily Mass. When she learned of the interdict under which her city had been placed, and there were no Masses or Holy Communion being offered she walked every day to a remote sanctuary outside of Genoa in order to go to Communion. When she was told that she was overdoing things she replied: "If I had to go miles and miles over burning coals in order to receive Jesus, I would say the way was easy, as if I were walking on a carpet of roses".




