Dear Beloved of God,

Happy Feast of Corpus Christi!! May God give you a profound devotion to the Most Blessed Sacrament.

On this day in 1976 the Mission of St. John Bosco was formally dedicated and has served the people of the area ever since. Today we will celebrate Mass with joy remembering the Gift of the Holy Eucharist and after the Mass we will enjoy each other's company at a picnic at the Hannibal Picnic area.

Speaking of anniversaries of dedications we also have in this same week the anniversary of the dedication of our church in Miltonsburg. St. John the Baptist Church was dedicated on June 8th 1901. The cornerstone was laid in 1900. To celebrate the occasion we will change our Mass schedule on Tuesday June 8th and offer the Holy Eucharist at 5:30 p.m. that day instead of 9:00 a.m. and afterwards go to the parish hall for a pot luck dinner.

There is another change as well in the Mass schedule for this week. On Friday, June 11th the Church celebrates the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. We will celebrate it in our parish with a traditional Latin Mass at 6:00 p.m. that day and cancel the 8:30 a.m. Mass that is usually said on Fridays.

On Saturday, June 12th the Church celebrates the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary and so at St. Sylvester's the Mass will be at noon that day. The sisters of the Children of Mary are due to arrive from Newark, Ohio and will be with us throughout the weekend. On Saturday they will give a series of talks to encourage us in our devotion to the Lord. The day will begin at 9:00 a.m. with breakfast in the Church basement. There will also be lunch included in the schedule at 1:00 p.m. Mass will be celebrated at noon. There will be a break from 2:45 p.m. until 4:30 p.m. and then the rosary will be prayed as usual with confessions being offered before the 5:00 p.m. Mass. At 6:00 p.m. there will be a light dinner again in the church basement followed by the final talk and time for questions and answers. So it will be a full day. I sure hope that everyone will try to make it though because the sisters are lively and have a great message to give to all of us. I am enclosing a schedule of the day in this bulletin.

I hope everyone will have a great week. God's blessings and peace be with each of you.


