



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This is the First Sunday of Lent. May the Lord grant us the grace to make a very good Lent and may we be completely cleansed of our sins and reconciled to God and to one another.

This is also the day the Diocese of Steubenville begins in earnest the campaign to raise the necessary funds for the operations of the Chancery. The money is used to educate our seminarians, care for retired priests, educate our youth through Catholic schools, religious education programs and youth ministry, assist the poor through Catholic Charities and other local efforts and much more. Last year our two parishes did not meet the goals set by the Diocese but this year we hope to do better. Our goals are the following: At St. Sylvester's Church the goal for the DPSC this year is \$28,307.82. The goal for St. John's is \$15,798.59. We have about 150 people coming to our three weekend Masses. Of course there are other parishioners who do not attend regularly our weekend Masses. If we each gave very sacrificially to this campaign we could indeed raise the money the Diocese needs for its operations. I am asking therefore that we all try to give as much as possible this year.

Perhaps some of our people are wondering about whether the Diocese of Steubenville and the Diocese of Columbus are going to merge. Our Diocesan Administrator, Bishop Paul Bradley has been working hard assessing whether or not it would be beneficial to merge and it seems he is coming to the conclusion that the Steubenville Diocese has the resources and the desire to remain as it is and if properly motivated will continue to exist as a separate Diocese for years to come. No decision has been made yet but things are looking favorable that we will remain a separate Diocese from Columbus. Time will tell. At any rate, I hope this uncertainty doesn't affect our giving to the DPSC. Whatever decision is made in a few months the Diocese will continue to need the proper funding in order to continue with the programs that are currently being funded by this yearly campaign.

This week in our parishes the Mass schedule and adoration on Wednesday are as usual. Lent is a great time to kick-start our spiritual lives and a good way to do so would be to attend daily Mass as much as our schedule allows. The adoration program on Wednesdays is also a great help to deepening our walk with God during these forty days of Lent. Of course, the weekly Stations of the Cross on Fridays is also a wonderful addition to deepening our appreciation for the sacrifice Christ made for our salvation. I might mention as well that we pray the morning prayer from the Liturgy of the hours and have a holy hour each Tuesday and Thursday at St. John's beginning at 8:00 a.m. The holy hour is then followed by the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass at 9:00 a.m. May God bless each of us as we try to draw closer to Him in these grace-filled days of Lent.
