Dear Beloved of God,

I hope that this Lenten season has been rich in God's abundant graces as you have prayed and fasted and assisted the less fortunate. Easter will soon be here but first we must travel the way of the cross in union with Our Divine Savior. Holy Thursday Mass will give us the opportunity to experience with Jesus the mystery of His self-offering as He gives His apostles for the first time His own Sacred Body and Blood and commands them to continue what He did as His priests. Our Mass will be at 7:00 p.m. followed by a Eucharistic Procession inside of the Church to the Altar of repose. You are invited to spend some time in adoration before leaving the Church. Many graces are available to those who spend some time with Jesus on this holy night.

Then, on Good Friday, a day of fast and prayer we will experience the stations of the cross with our beloved Lord and God at noon at St. John the Baptist Church and spend some time in prayerful silence and communal prayer until 3:00 p.m. at which time we will begin the first day of the Novena of Divine Mercy which will then be prayed every day at 3:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's Church until the Sunday of Divine Mercy which follows that of Easter Sunday. The Good Friday Liturgical service will be held at 7:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's. Everyone should participate in that together remembering what Jesus did for us and for the whole world. No meat is eaten on Good Friday and for those who are 18 years of age up to 59 years are only allowed one meal. Two small snacks may also be eaten as long as they do not equal another meal.

The Easter Vigil will begin at 8:00 p.m. on Saturday and will consist of several readings as well as the blessing of the new water and the procession with candles. We will celebrate the most glorious night of the whole year as we recall the victory of Christ over sin and death. In union with Him we too hope to rise to eternal glory. On Easter Sunday we will have the usual Masses at each of the three churches in Monroe County.

I hope that this Holy Week will indeed be a holy week for each and every one of you. God bless you!!
