Dear Beloved of God,

Happy Mothers' Day!! I hope your day will be truly blessed. And may Mary, our Mother watch over and guide us all to our eternal home.

This weekend we would like to welcome Father Joseph Tuscan OFM to our community. Father Joseph is a Franciscan Capuchin belonging to the same Franciscan family as St. Padre Pio and Blessed Solanus Casey as well as many other holy Capuchins. He is a skilled retreat director and will be here for a few days to help renew our Monroe county Catholic communities. Father Tuscan will be preaching at all the Masses this weekend and then starting Sunday evening at 5:30 p.m. he will give the first of several "Mission Talks". The talk will be at St. Sylvester's and everyone should come so that as a community we can benefit from Father Tuscan's wisdom and be renewed in the Holy Spirit. He will give a total of two more talks as well. There will be one on Monday evening at 5:30 p.m. and one on Tuesday evening at the same time. All these talks aim to deepen our spirituality and strengthen our faith and they will all occur at St. Sylvester's Church. No other parish meetings should occur during the parish mission. The Mission will be over by Tuesday evening. Mass will be celebrated on Monday and Tuesday in the context of the parish Mission at 5:30 p.m. and so there will be no morning Masses on Monday and Tuesday of this week.

On this coming Thursday I will be celebrating a Latin sung Mass at St. Alphonsus Church in Wheeling, W.Va. and I invite everyone to join me there if possible. The Mass will begin at noon and will be the Mass of the Ascension. May 13<sup>th</sup> is also the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima and so we would like to make that day special for the Mother of God by celebrating a beautiful Mass in honor of her Son's glorious Ascension into Heaven.

I'm not sure yet when the Bishop will lift the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass but I have a feeling it won't be too much longer. Once it is lifted we will be under serious obligation to assist at Sunday Mass in its entirety which means arriving before the Mass begins and staying until the Mass is ended. I have noticed how some people like to leave right after Holy Communion but of course this is not right. It is also disrespectful to the rest of our community and to God. I would suggest that everyone begin now to get into the habit of attending Sunday Mass so that when the day comes that we will be under obligation to do so we will be already accustomed to doing so anyway. Once the dispensation is lifted we will commit mortal sin if we miss Mass through our own fault. And mortal sin deprives the soul of sanctifying grace without which we cannot enter into Heaven when we die. Mortal sin needs to be forgiven through the Sacrament of Reconciliation which is like a renewal of Baptism in which we were washed of sin.

May the Lord grant each of you a peaceful week and a true renewal of faith as you participate in the parish Mission.


