





On Monday, June 19<sup>th</sup> I will offer Mass at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's and then I am leaving for Greenville, S. Carolina to visit my youngest sister. I'll be gone until June 28<sup>th</sup>. There will be no weekday Masses during that time. Next weekend Father Marty Holler from our Diocese will be here to offer the Masses. He will be speaking about the work of UNBOUND, a lay Catholic sponsorship ministry that helps children and elderly in 19 developing countries.
