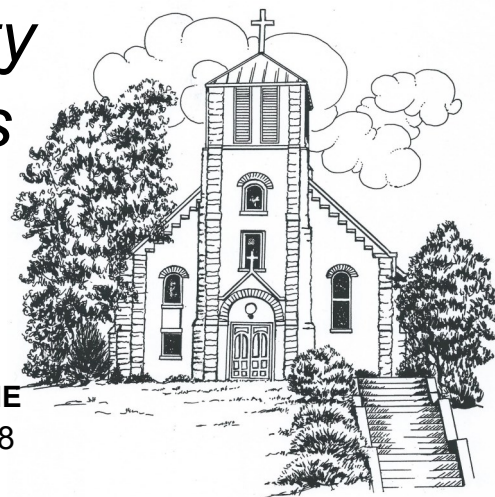

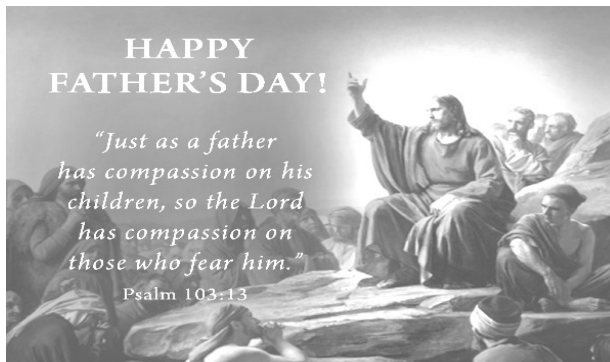

First of all I would like to wish all of the fathers of our parish a very HAPPY FATHERS' DAY!! May the good Lord look upon you kindly and grant you wisdom to know how to be a good and compassionate father in imitation of our Heavenly Father.

On Monday, June 19th I will offer Mass at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's and then I am leaving for Greenville, S. Carolina to visit my youngest sister. I'll be gone until June 28th. There will be no weekday Masses during that time. Next weekend Father Marty Holler from our Diocese will be here to offer the Masses. He will be speaking about the work of UNBOUND, a lay Catholic sponsorship ministry that helps children and elderly in 19 developing countries. I'll be offering the Mass at St. John's on Thursday, June 29th, the Feast of St. Peter and Paul at 9:00 a.m. with the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. preceding the Mass as usual. And then on Friday, June 30th I'll have Mass at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's. On Saturday, July 1st the Mass will be at 8:30 a.m. for the First Saturday with rosary at 7:30 a.m. and guided meditation after the rosary, preceding the Holy Mass. This will be at St. Sylvester's as normal.

On June 21st and June 28th we will not have the Eucharistic Adoration that we usually have since I will be gone.

The summertime is here and offers us some great opportunities to spend time with God admiring the beauty of His creation and just sitting in admiration of His grandeur. We might also think about those who cannot get outside because they are confined to their beds for one reason or another.
