Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This week we will have a very special event occurring in the parish. Our Lady of Guadalupe's image will be arriving on Friday and we are planning a special greeting at 6:30 p.m. in the parking lot. The image will be solemnly "escorted" to the Church where we will celebrate Mass at St. Sylvester's and then pray our rosary and have a short talk about the apparition of Our Lady to St. Juan Diego in 1531. I am looking forward to her visit knowing that she is the Queen of Heaven and Earth. The great Feast of the Assumption will be celebrated two days later, on Sunday, August 15th. The image will remain in the Church from August 13th through August 15th. The Church will be open during the daylight hours for people to come and pray in front of the image. Many miracles are reported to have happened when the pilgrim image is venerated. Our holy Mother wants us to come to her and present her with our difficulties and problems. She is truly a good Mother to all of the disciples of Jesus. Next Sunday evening at 7:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's we will have a Eucharistic Holy Hour to honor her Divine Son. I hope that everyone will receive Our Lady and spend some time with her in prayer during the day on Saturday, August 14th or Sunday August 15th or on both days if you have time!! You will be greatly blessed. One more detail of next weekend's schedule includes a Marian time of hymns and a talk by Judy Hutchinson from Barnesville who is helping to co-ordinate the visit of Our lady. That Marian time of praise and song and the talk will begin right after the 5:00 p.m. Mass on August 14th.

Our Lady's image will be visiting various homes of the faithful until September $3^{\rm rd}$ when she will be taken to the Catholic Churches at Caldwell. Let me know if you have any questions.

Daily Masses this week will be pretty normal. On Monday, August 9th the daily Mass is at 5:30 p.m. Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday's Masses are the same as usual but on Friday the 8:30 a.m. Mass will be cancelled and we'll have Mass around 6:45 p.m. after the image has been received and brought into the Church. On Saturday, August 14th the Latin Mass will occur as usual at 8:30 a.m.

During these troubling times let us pray daily the holy rosary and attend Mass as often as possible and of course every Sunday and Holy Day. Our greatest Help is God. Our Lady and the saints give us their prayers as well whenever we ask them to do so and of course we pray for each other, hopefully every day. God bless and keep you in His love.

The Assumption (August 15) refers to the Blessed Virgin Mary being assumed — body and soul — into heaven at the end of her earthly life. "Assumption" is different than "ascension" because one is passive (i.e. one is assumed) and the other is active (i.e. one ascends). It is by the power of God Mary was assumed.

As evidenced by the writings of many early Church fathers, Christians have believed for more than a millennium that the Blessed Virgin was assumed into heaven. In 1950, Pope

Pius XII issued Munificentissimus Deus, which officially defined the **Dogma** of the Assumption. This means that the Church officially recognizes this belief as a true and necessary part of our Catholic beliefs about Mary. Like all beliefs about Mary, they illuminate our most treasured beliefs about her Son. The Assumption illustrates to us the truth about Christ's promise of eternal life and the resurrection of the faithful.


