

Dear Brothers & Sister in Christ,

The last day of 2023!! I hope that everyone is grateful for the blessings bestowed by God upon us this year that is ending. For some this has been a challenging year. For others a year of happiness and peace. But for all God has been a refuge and strength. I hope that as the New Year begins this Sunday night each and everyone of us will experience in an even deeper and profound way the love God has for us. May we grow even more in love with God Who is our Father and Who sent His Divine Son to rescue us and His Spirit to sanctify us. Happy New Year everyone!!

Our New Year will begin with two Masses on Monday morning. The first Mass will be at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's and the second will begin at 10:30 a.m. at St. John the Baptist. The Feast we will be celebrating is the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God. It is also the World Day of Prayer for peace. Even though the obligation to attend Mass has been lifted from this Holy Day because it falls on a Monday, I hope that each of us will do our best to attend one of the two Masses being offered. It will be a very good way to begin the year 2024.

And I just wanted to encourage those who belong to St. Sylvester's Parish to attend the coffee and donuts social in the church basement after the Mass this Sunday, December 31st. it is the Patronal Feast of St. Sylvester. The Knights of Columbus will be providing the coffee and donuts and they ask only for a donation to the Knights so that they can continue doing the charitable things that they do. St. Sylvester was Pope from 314 to 335 AD. He was the first Pope to reign after the Edict of Constantine granting permission for the Catholic Church to legally exist in the Roman Empire. He began the work on some of the major basilicas and some say that he actually baptized Constantine. St. Sylvester, pray for us!!

The Masses on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of this week are as usual but the Mass on Friday, since it will be the First Friday of the month, will be at 7:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's with a holy hour preceding it at 6:00 p.m. The Holy Hour and the Mass will be offered in reparation for the sins committed against the Sacred Heart of Jesus, especially the sins against the Holy Eucharist. In a small way we will try to make up for the neglect and disregard for the tremendous gift of the Body and Blood of the Lord offered to us at Mass. Come and join us if you can.

On Saturday, January 6th, traditional date of the Epiphany and this year, the First Saturday of the month, there will be Mass at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's but no pot luck breakfast this time. I will be going to St. Alphonsus Church in Wheeling, W.Va. to bless Epiphany Water at 11:00 a.m. The blessing involves exorcism of the salt and water and lengthy prayers invoking God's love and mercy. Everyone is invited to attend and there will be a reception after the Blessing in the parish hall of St. Alphonsus.
