Dear Friends in Christ,

The seventh annual Eucharistic Rosary Congress is being held this week (Oct.7<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup>) in three different locations in the Steubenville Diocese. Our Diocese is doing this along with other dioceses throughout the U.S. to pray in reparation and adoration in response to Our Lady of Fatima's plea for prayer and conversion. The three locations in our Diocese are: Steubenville, Marietta, and Ironton. You may inquire about the details for each place by calling the following people: in Marietta contact Shelly at 740-525-6360. In Ironton contact Randy at <u>rlilly316@yahoo.com</u>. And in Steubenville go to: <u>https://signup.com/go/XvtqpDK</u>. Here at our parish of St. Sylvester's we will pray the rosary during each hour of the adoration program this Wednesday, October 11<sup>th</sup>. The adorer for each hour should lead the Holy Rosary at the beginning of their particular hour so that by the end of the adoration period we will have prayed the rosary 11 times. On the back of the bulletin we have listed which mysteries might be prayed at which hour of the adoration schedule. In this way we will be joining in with other adorers throughout the U.S. in response to Our Lady's Fatima request.

I think by now if you have read my letters and heard me speak at Mass you know that I believe very much in the apparitions of Fatima. I usually try to have some literature in the vestibule of the Church regarding Fatima. And I highly encourage anyone who might be able to do so to travel to Fatima to make a spiritual pilgrimage and be immersed in the story of Our Lady's visit and the messages that she left us. This coming Friday, October 13<sup>th</sup> is the anniversary of the miracle of the sun at Fatima. It was the miracle Our Lady had promised Lucia, Francisco, and Jacinta to help the people believe in the apparitions. It was perhaps the greatest public miracle since Our Lord's coming 2,000 years ago. We are living in a time of great grace and a truly Marian epoch of the Catholic Church. During the apparitions at Fatima Our Holy Mother asked specifically for the prayer of the holy rosary to aid in the conversion of sinners and to bring peace to the world. October is the month of the Holy Rosary and it would please Our Lady if we all made the commitment to pray it every day. St. Padre Pio prayed many rosaries every day and usually always carried the rosary in his wounded hands urging everyone to pray it.

Here is another quote from the little book: JESUS OUR EUCHARISTIC LOVE by Fr. Stefano Manelli:

"The words of the consecration are the most wonderful and awesome words that God has given to the Church. They have the power through the priest, to transform a bit of bread and wine into our Crucified God, Jesus!! They achieve this wonderful, mysterious feat in virtue of that supreme power surpassing the power of the Seraphim, a power which belongs only to God and is shared by His priests. We should wonder that there have been holy priests who suffered a great deal when they pronounced those divine words. St. Joseph of Cupertino, and in our time St. Pio of Pietrelchina, appeared visibly weighed down with distress. Only with difficulty and with pauses did they manage to complete the two formulas of consecration."

I as a priest of Jesus Christ am humbled by the power vested in me and I ask everyone to pray for me that I may be worthy of this high vocation. And pray that the Lord might call other men into the service at the altar. God bless and keep you all in His great love.
