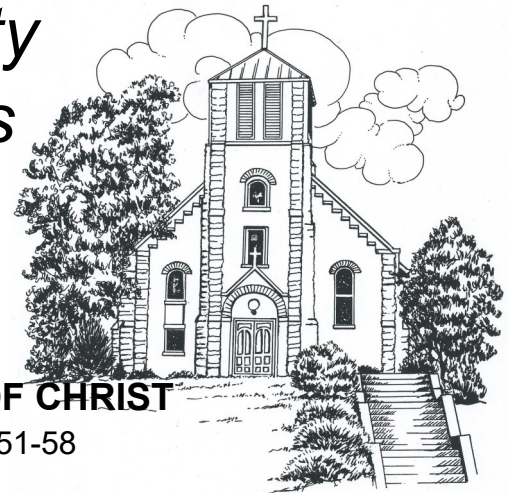
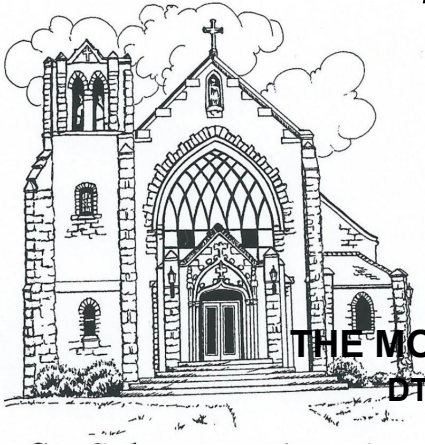

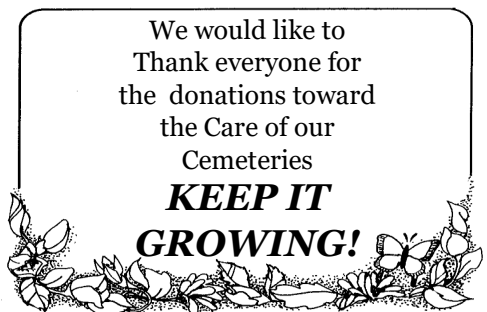

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday we begin our week with the solemn celebration of the Feast of CORPUS CHRISTI. I have included on a separate sheet some words of Padre Pio regarding how we should treat the Lord's house. The church building is a very sacred place because of the presence of the Lord Himself whose Body and Blood is present in the tabernacle. Please read the words of this great saint of the 20th century who continues to touch the lives of millions of people even today years after his death. His body is incorrupt at San Giovanni Rotondo where he lived out his life in great suffering and prayer for many years. San Giovanni Rotondo is the third most visited place in the world for Catholic pilgrimage groups. I had the privilege of being there on two separate occasions. Padre Pio has had a profound effect on my life as a priest.

Looking ahead at the end of this week we have two wonderful Feasts to celebrate. On Friday, June 16th the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. And on Saturday, June 17th we will celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. On both days the Mass will be offered at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's. Please make a sincere effort to be present as we honor the sacred hearts of Jesus and Mary at those Masses. You might remember that June is the month of the Sacred Heart and we are encouraged to adore His Heart so full of love for us sinners and to make reparation for the sins committed against that most Sacred Heart.

May God bless you throughout the coming week and fill you with thanksgiving for all that He has done for us. May the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary be your sure refuge.
