We are already arriving at the end of February!! March 1st is on Wednesday of this week. We are into Lent for a week already. I hope that these special days will help us all to be renewed in our holy faith.

PARISH MISSION

Speaking of renewal of the faith, this weekend (Feb. 25th-26th) Father Eudes will be with us at each of the weekend Masses and will preach the homily. Father Eudes is a member of the Canons of the Holy Cross located in Carrolton, Ohio. I invited him to come to our parishes here in Monroe County and help us as we begin Lent. In addition to the homilies at our weekend Masses Father Eudes will also give a series of talks starting on Sunday evening at 6:00 p.m. His talk will be about mental prayer. And then on Monday and Tuesday he will give an additional two talks, on Monday the theme will be Lectio Divino and on Tuesday evening, the hidden world of the angels. These talks will also be at 6:00 p.m. and will occur at St. Sylvester's parish. We have provided a flier in the bulletin for the last couple of Sundays for your convenience. Father Eudes will also celebrate Mass on Monday, February 27th at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester and on Tuesday, February 28th at 9:00 a.m. at St. John the Baptist Church in Miltonsburg. After each of the talks confessions will be available. This is a great opportunity and I'll be sorely disappointed if we don't take advantage of it.
