

Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday is the WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS. It is a day to remember to pray that God send more workers into His great harvest. We especially need more priests for our Diocese. The numbers of priests serving in the Steubenville Diocese continues to diminish and without priests there is no Mass and no confessions. And we also need holy women and men consecrated to God in religious life. They are a very important part of the life of the Church. And while we are praying for more vocations let us also pray in thanksgiving for those priests and religious who are presently serving God in the Church. And so if you could offer a rosary today for this intention that would be very good.

Our Mass schedule this week is our normal schedule.

On Mothers' Day we will celebrate First Communions of several of our children. Their names are: JOBY ANTHONY COLE, DANIE RAE LYNN WOODELL, NYLIE MARIE WOODELL, HOLDEN NEIL DIXON, JACKSON A. MILLER and later on when he is ready ARIEL VILLA. His date has not yet been set. His brother, Cesar will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation on Monday June 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:00 p.m. at St. John's Church in Bellaire. Let us keep these children in our prayers. We are allowed to present children as young as those in fifth grade to the Bishop for Confirmation. If there are any children ready to begin preparation for Confirmation next year please let me know. I will tell the new priest about this. I know there must be children from our school and from public schools who are in fifth grade and up. Confirmation received devoutly helps to strengthen the baptismal commitment of the recipients and makes them stronger in resisting temptations. Usually the classes for Confirmation begin in the Fall semester but it would be helpful to have a list of names to present to the new priest when he comes so that he can prepare.

I just want to end with this little quote from St. Faustina: "It is You Jesus, stretched out on the cross, who gives me strength and are always close to the suffering soul. Creatures will abandon a person in his suffering, but You, O Lord are faithful." Let us remember this when we are suffering.
