Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Valentine's Day to all of you. We begin an important week as we will be entering into the Lenten Fast starting on Wednesday.

Visit from the Sisters of the Children of Mary

On Tuesday of this week several sisters of the religious order called Sisters of the Children of Mary will be coming to visit us. They will attend the 9:00 a.m. Mass at St. John the Baptist in Miltonsburg and then travel to St. Sylvester's School to talk to the children about their religious vocation. For most of the school's existence we had religious sisters teaching in the school but now that is no longer the case. I think it is important that our children are given some exposure to consecrated religious so that if the Lord calls some of our girls to religious life they will have had at least some contact with sisters. If you happen to see the sisters out at St. John's or around the parish please welcome them warmly.

Ash Wednesday: February 17th

This coming Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, a day of fast and prayer. Those who are between the ages of 18 and 59 are required to fast on only one meal. Two small snacks are permitted in addition to the main meal as long as they don't equal another meal. Something like an apple or a few crackers would qualify as a snack. No meat is permitted to be eaten that day and this requirement extends to all those who have completed their 14th birthday. Our Masses for Ash Wednesday are the following:

8:30 a.m. school Mass at St. Sylvester's 10:30 a.m. Mass at St. John the Baptist 12:30 p.m. Mass at St. John Bosco in Sardis

7:00 p.m. Mass at St. Sylvester's

Ashes will be distributed at each of the above Masses.

Fridays of Lent

On the Fridays of Lent, (observed as days of abstinence from meat by all those who have reached the age of 14) Our Mass will be offered at the usual time: 8:30 a.m. and the younger children from the school will be in attendance. Everyone is welcome to attend.

From 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. a Fish dinner will be served on some of the Fridays of Lent by the Knights of Columbus and the details are on the flier that has been stuffed into the bulletin. Note that the Fish Dinners will not be served every Friday.

Stations of the Cross will be prayed each Friday of Lent at St. Sylvester's Church at 7:00 p.m.

Lenten Resolutions

Lent is a time to deepen our life of prayer and a time to do penance for our sins. It is also a time to perform works of charity and be renewed in our Christian faith. Please consider well what prayer practices you will be doing this Lent. Consider attending daily Mass and perhaps joining in with the small group that adores the Blessed Sacrament every Tuesday and Thursday at St. John's from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Also consider taking a weekly holy hour on Wednesdays between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's. Lent offers us an opportunity to meditate more profoundly on the sufferings of our Lord and so every Friday consider attending the Stations of the Cross at St. Sylvester's at 7:00 p.m. To be renewed in our Christian faith is the goal of the Lenten season. In order for that to become a reality we each need to have some periods of silence and freedom from the distractions of social media or the t. v. and radio. Reading the Bible or some good spiritual book can be of great help to us spiritually. Also, doing acts of penance and mortification can train us to value those things that really matter as we make our pilgrimage of life. Lent is really a forty day retreat in imitation of the forty days that Jesus spent in the desert preparing for His public ministry. We too are called to withdraw as much as possible from the world in order to experience God in the depths of our hearts. Let us pray for each other that we will indeed have a fruitful Lent and repent of our sins. Please make a good confession at some point during the Lenten period in preparation for experiencing the new life the Lord wants to give us at Easter.


