





Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday is the Fifth Sunday of Lent. Next Sunday is Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week. We will have Mass next weekend at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday as usual and two Masses on Palm Sunday. We will have an 8:30 a.m. Mass at St. Sylvester's and a 10:30 a.m. Mass at St. John's. If I am a little late getting out to St. John's it's because Palm Sunday Liturgy takes a little longer.

Our schedule for Holy Week is the following:

Monday, March 25^{th} Mass will be at 8:30 a.m. followed by Stations of the Cross with the school.

Tuesday, March 26^{th} Mass will be at 9:00 a.m. Also, there is the Chrism Mass at 2:00 p.m. at the Basilica of Our Lady in Marietta. Bishop encourages everyone to attend if possible.

Wednesday, March 27th there will be exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and all day adoration concluding at 6:00 p.m. with Benediction and then 6:30 p.m. Mass.

Holy Thursday, March 28th Mass will be at 7:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's.

Good Friday, March 29th. Stations of the Cross at noon at St. John's. 3:00 p.m. Divine Mercy Novena starts at St. Sylvester's. Good Friday Service at 7:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's.

Holy Saturday 3:00 p.m. Divine Mercy Novena at St. Sylvester's. 8:00 p.m. Easter Vigil.

Easter Sunday, March 31st: 8:30 a.m. Mass at St. Sylvester's. 10:30 a.m. Mass at St. John's. 3;00 p.m. Novena of Divine Mercy—everyday this week until next Sunday, April 7th.

Please mark your calendars with these dates and try to attend these services for a Holy Week.

The statues and images in the Church are covered with purple cloth to mark the transition in the Lenten season of this last part of Lent. The focus now is more on the sufferings our Lord endured for our salvation. The images will be unveiled for Easter.

On Tuesday, March 19th of this present week we will celebrate the Feast of St. Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is celebrated as a solemnity. Our Mass that day will be offered at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's with the school children. It will be followed by confessions for the students. On Friday, March 22nd we will have Mass at 8:30 a.m. but it will not be a school Mass since the school Mass will have been celebrated already on March 19th. Stations of the Cross will be prayed at 7:00 p.m. as usual.
