

Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. The Church celebrates the fact that God has shown His mercy to the whole world in the death and resurrection of His Divine Son. That mercy is like an ocean. It is immeasurable and available to every human being. It is wide and deep and infinite. Our part in this mystery of God's love is to offer prayers that God's mercy may overcome the barriers of sin and engulf the whole world in the Good News. To honor God on this day I have scheduled a holy hour from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's Church.

I am sure that most of us have fallen away Catholics in our families. We might consider offering our holy hour for their conversion that they return to the sacraments. We most likely all have someone who is sick and suffering among our friends or family members and perhaps some who are approaching their deaths. We might consider offering our holy hour for them that they may bear their sufferings in union with Christ and if they are nearing their deaths that they might be reconciled with God and die having received the Sacrament of the Sick. I hope to see you there at the holy hour today on Divine Mercy Sunday.

Our Mass schedule this week is normal. In this Easter season we bask in the light of His resurrection and rejoice that He has overcome the world. Please consider coming to daily Mass when you can.

On Saturday, April 22nd we will be taking five of our young people to Newark, Ohio to the Sisters of the Children of Mary. They will have a few hours of prayer and reflection as they prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation to be administered by Bishop Monforton on May 2nd at 5:00 p.m. I have been giving instructions to these youngsters since last Fall and they are almost ready to receive the Holy Spirit in the strengthening that comes from the Sacrament of Confirmation. They will be made courageous witnesses to Jesus Christ in the midst of a world that so often refuses to recognize His authority and mission. Let us pray for these candidates as well as for their sponsors and parents.

Again quoting from the book: Jesus our Eucharistic Love by Stefano Manelli: "Daily Communion is a daily wellspring or source of love, of strength, of light, of joy, of courage, of every virtue and every good. 'If anyone thirst, let him come to Me and drink,' Jesus said. He alone is the Fountain of water springing up unto life everlasting. How can there be anyone in the state of sanctifying grace who does not want, or who finds it hard, to go this divine 'table of the Lord'".

God bless and sanctify you and your families and grant you a week of blessings.


