Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are in a three year period of renewal of Eucharistic devotion called for by the Bishops of the U.S. As you know I have been encouraging more frequent reception of Holy Communion so that every day we can be fed with the "daily Bread" of Christ's true Body and Blood. Very few have heeded my words and at times I get a little discouraged. If we only knew the value of a single Holy Communion we would make whatever sacrifices were necessary so as to assist at the Sacrifice of the Mass and receive devoutly the most Blessed Sacrament. St. Francis de Sales rightly said: "Those who have little to do must receive Communion often, since it is not inconvenient for them; the same also goes for those who have much to do, since then they have more need of it". St. Joseph Moscati, the famous physician of Naples would organize his day about this, and go to unbelievable lengths (at the cost of enormous inconvenience, especially in view of the frequent trips he had to make) to avoid missing daily Communion. If on any day it was quite impossible to receive Communion, he had not the courage that day to make his doctor's calls; for he said, "Without Jesus, I do not have enough light to save my poor patients". And how many times he would advise for his patients Confession and Communion as first treatment!!

As you know we are passing through an eclipse of the faith as Pope Benedict famously said. So many Catholic Churches have been closed!! So many Catholics do not practice the faith!! Very few young men are entering the seminaries. And very few young women want to become sisters. The young people have abandoned the faith in unprecedented numbers. This is definitely the time for those who are persevering in the faith to draw strength from the sacraments of the Church and to receive the sacraments more often than ever before. We all need to pray and unabashedly proclaim our loyalty to Jesus Christ and live fully in His Kingdom. My dear brothers and sisters I ask you to try to take advantage of the three year period of Eucharistic renewal and at every opportunity try to participate in Eucharistic adoration on Wednesdays and on other days such as Tuesday and Thursday mornings. This is not the time to be half-hearted in our devotion to Jesus truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. It is instead a call to arm ourselves fully with the graces we will receive from daily Communion and frequent adoration.

May the good and gracious God give to each of you an increase in faith and zealous determination to be truly Catholic as never before.
