Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are in a special Octave of Prayer for Christian Unity. It started last Thursday, January 18th. Here is another quote from the little book JESUS OUR EUCHARISTIC LOVE. "Once the Bishop of Manfredonia, Msgr. Cesarano, chose St. Pio's friary to make an eight day retreat. Each night the bishop got up at various times to go to the chapel, and each night despite the different hours, he always found St. Pio in adoration. The great apostle of the Gargano was working throughout the world unseen---and sometimes seen, as in instances of bilocation—while he remained there prostrate before Jesus, with his rosary in his hands. He used to tell his spiritual children, 'when you want to find me, come near the tabernacle'. At St. Sylvester's Church we have the church opened and Eucharistic adoration going on from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. every Wednesday.
