



Dear Friends in Christ,

This week there will be hundreds of priests gathering at Oglebay Park for a conference and I'll be among them. The conference begins on Monday, July 10<sup>th</sup> and runs until Thursday, July 13<sup>th</sup>. Before going to the conference I will have Mass at St. Sylvester's at 8:30 a.m. on Monday, July 10<sup>th</sup>. But, there will be no Masses on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. And there will also be no adoration on Wednesday, July 12<sup>th</sup>. I will resume the Mass on Friday, July 14<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's. The conference features Dr. Scott Hahn, Dr. John Bergsma and others who have gained much knowledge about the Bible and teachings of the Church. I have gone for the past two years and have received much from what has been presented by these experts.

I haven't quoted from the little book called JESUS, OUR EUCHARISTIC LOVE by Father Stephano Manelli FI for a while and so here is a quote that might help each of us acquire an even deeper love for Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. "The holy Cure of Ars told his flock: 'at the sight of a church tower you can say: Jesus is there, for there a priest has celebrated Mass." Blessed Louis Guanella, when he was travelling by train on pilgrimage to various shrines, used always to advise pilgrims to turn their minds and hearts to Jesus every time they saw a church tower from the carriage window, 'Every bell tower' he would say, indicates a church, where there is a tabernacle, where Mass is said, and where Jesus stays." Of course we only have two Catholic Churches in Monroe County but every time we pass them we can bow our heads and say a short prayer such as "Jesus I love you in the Blessed Sacrament". And for sure Jesus hears us and grants us an increase in grace to love Him more.

During this time of the year many people are taking vacations and the attendance at Church decreases and as a result the collection also decreases. Please remember to give your fair share of money even when you are away from the parish. Please also remember to support the apostolate of the school and the maintenance of our cemeteries. We have to maintain seven of them. And finally please help us to reach our goal for the DPSC campaign. We need everyone to contribute, please.


