



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Happy Feast of the Epiphany!! May the mystery of God's appearing on earth so touch your hearts that you are filled with the most profound thanksgiving and praise of our merciful God.

School starts this Monday. Hopefully the kids and teachers and parents are ready and had a good Christmas. On Monday the Church celebrates the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord and the end of the Christmas season. In the traditional calendar, however, the season ends on February 2nd, the Presentation of the Child Jesus in the Temple. So some people will leave the decorations up until then but most will take them down or have already done so. Ordinary Time begins then this week and it will last until February 14th, which will be Ash Wednesday.

During this time, I would like to invite everyone to participate in an adult learning experience. We will be looking at the videos of Brant Pitre on the Eucharist. The series is called: Eucharist, discovering the Mass in the Bible. Brant Pitre is an amazing scripture scholar and is extremely good at helping others to appreciate the Bible's riches. The classes will begin this Monday, January 8th right after the 5:30 p.m. Mass at St. Sylvester's and will last for ten sessions. As you know we are in a three-year cycle of the National Eucharistic revival and so I thought it was appropriate that we delve more deeply into the mystery of the Holy Eucharist.

I have been considering retirement from active ministry for several years and recently have decided to do so with Bishop Bradley's permission. I will be moving to the Greenville, South Carolina area and living with one of my sister and her husband. I plan to be active at their parish called Prince of Peace. It is a large parish and I have been there several times for weddings and baptisms of my nephews and nieces and their children. My sister has 13 children and 39 grandchildren so she and her husband keep very busy and it will be great living with them. The date of my retirement will be July 1st 2024 and I will be moving on that date.

It came to my attention that since coming to St. Sylvester's and St. John's parishes in August of 2019 we had not been paying the monthly retirement assessment. Each parish is assessed a certain amount for the priest's retirement. We owed \$18,000.00 for this assessment. Rather than obliging the parish to pay the full amount, Bishop Bradley has authorized the Diocese to provide half of the amount from a designated fund, leaving the parish's responsibility to be only \$9,000.00.

Bishop Bradley will make sure that our parishes will receive the pastoral care they need from another priest. It has not yet been announced who that priest will be. In the meantime I will continue to serve our parishes to the best of my ability until July 1st.

Please keep me and all priests in your prayers.
