Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our Mass schedule for this coming week has changed somewhat because of the Holy Day of Obligation, November 1st and the Feast of All Souls, November 2nd. For the Solemnity of All Saints our Mass schedule is as follows:

Monday, October 31st a 5:30 p.m. Vigil Mass will be offered at St. Sylvester's Tuesday, November 1st an 8:30 a.m. School Mass will be offered at St. Sylvester's Tuesday, November 1st a 7:00 p.m. Mass will be offered at St. John the Baptist So, three Masses will be available for the Solemnity of All Saints which is a Holy Day. For the Feast of All Souls our Mass schedule will be as follows:

Wednesday, November 2^{nd} a noon Mass will be offered at St. John's in Miltonsburg Wednesday, November 2^{nd} a 6:30 p.m. Mass will be offered at St. Sylvester's And so two Masses will be offered for the Poor Souls in Purgatory.

Adoration on Wednesday, November 2nd will begin at St. Sylvester's as usual at 8:00 a.m. and extend until 6:00 p.m. when Benediction will be celebrated followed by Mass at 6:30 p.m.

The month of November is dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory and so daily Mass is encouraged as we pray for the departed who are suffering the pains of Purgatory. We have already printed a list of the rosaries that will be offered in each of our cemeteries from November 2nd through November 8th. I hope that you will join me on those days. The Church permits us to gain a plenary indulgence for the poor souls in Purgatory on those days simply by praying in a cemetery for those buried there. The other conditions for gaining a plenary indulgence must also be met, of course: confession, Holy Communion, and prayer for the Pope. And one must not have any attachment to sin. Last year the plenary indulgence could be gained on any day of November because of the pandemic. I am not too sure about this year, but I think it would be safe to say that November 1st through the 8th as before the Pandemic would be the dates when one can obtain a plenary indulgence for one soul.

This coming Friday is the First Friday of November and so our evening Mass will start at 7:00 p.m. followed then by the nine offices as we have been praying for the past several months. All those who have had their homes consecrated are particularly encouraged to participate in this First Friday devotion of reparation. Then, on Saturday, November 5th, the First Saturday we will have our Mass at 8:30 a.m. followed by a potluck breakfast. As you know I have been doing everything I can think of to encourage everyone to make the Five First Saturdays as Our Lady at Fatima requested. Recently I made available a nice publication on the First Saturday devotion. I hope you have obtained one and were able to read it.

As we begin this new month of November let us meditate on the four last things: death, judgement, heaven and hell. May God inspire us to prepare well for the hereafter. God bless.
