


Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

He is risen!! He is truly risen!! Let us rejoice in the splendor of His light!! Happy Easter everyone!!

For the next eight days the Church rejoices in the resurrection of her Lord and God. It is the octave of Easter. Each day we will pray the Gloria at the daily Masses and remember the glorious fact that Jesus was dead in His human nature and has come back to life. We will remember His various apparitions and how He cemented the faith of those first disciples. They gave witness to Him even to the shedding of their blood. May our hearts truly rejoice as well in the light of this awesome mystery of our faith. And may God raise us up too one day to eternal glory and life everlasting. Each Sunday we will celebrate this marvelous mystery of the resurrection and give a special place in our lives to the Day of the Lord. Each Sunday is a remembrance of the fact that Christ has triumphed over death. It is only right and just that we keep that day holy by attendance at the holy Sacrifice of the Mass and by refusing to do any unnecessary work. We are children of Light because of our Baptism and Alleluia is our song!! Let us rejoice in Christ Who is truly risen from the dead. May no sadness afflict us this day for rejoicing in the Lord must be our strength.

Please remember that each day this week at 3:00 p.m. we are praying the Novena to Divine Mercy in the church of St. Sylvester. if you can not be in the church at 3:00 p.m. please try to pray the Novena on your own as close to the 3:00 p.m. hour as possible. It was at 3:00 p.m. that Our Blessed Lord breathed His last and opened for us the Kingdom of Heaven. It is the hour par excellence of His merciful love. Next Sunday is the Sunday of Divine Mercy. It is a special day in which to celebrate with joy the mystery of Christ's mercy. He promised St. Faustina that on that day He would open the floodgates of Heaven and bestow mercy on all who ask for it. Do we not all need His mercy? I would think we do. At 3:00 p.m. on that day (April 7th) we will have a solemn praying of the Divine Mercy Novena in the church of St. Sylvester and conclude with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.

Our Masses will resume as normal this week as well as the adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament on Wednesday. The only change is that we will also include the Novena to Divine Mercy each day at 3:00 p.m. at St.. Sylvester's Church. However, since this coming Friday, April 5th is the First Friday of the month of April we will also include a Mass at 5:00 p.m. that day as well as an hour of adoration beginning around 5:30 p.m. and finishing at 6:30 p.m. Some of you are making the nine First Fridays in reparation for the sins committed against Our Lord especially sins against the Blessed Sacrament. That is why we have added an additional Mass this coming Friday.

If anyone would like to help the parish defray some of the costs of keeping the lawns mowed and trimmed please consider giving an extra gift each month of perhaps \$50.00 and ear marking it "for the Lawn care". We begin the mowing in April and conclude usually in October and your gift would help us tremendously during those six months. And thanks to those who are already doing so.
