Dear Friends in Christ,

We have arrived at the third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday in Latin. It is a call to rejoice because the Lord is near, even at the door of our hearts. The vestments worn at Mass may be a rose color signifying an increase in anticipation and joy at the thought that our Savior is about to be born anew in our hearts. I hope that this Sunday will indeed find you full of expectation and hope that Christ is about to come to you. The preceding weeks of Advent have offered us a time to deepen our prayer and perform some sacrifices to cleanse our hearts of sin and many of you have celebrated the Sacrament of Penance/ Reconciliation. There is still time to do so if you have not yet had the opportunity. Remember that I hear confessions from 4:00 p.m. to 4:45 p.m. every Saturday and on Sundays from 7:45 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. and as soon as I can get out to St. John's after the 8:30 a.m. Mass. And, of course if none of those times work for you just give me a call and we'll set up a special time at your convenience. It would be good if we all took advantage of this season of grace and confess our sins before we celebrate the beautiful Feast of the Nativity of the Lord.

This Monday is the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Our Mass will be celebrated at 8:30 a.m. with the school community at St. Sylvester's. But, of course everyone is welcome to come. At 5:00 p.m. in the basement of St. Sylvester's I will give a talk on the miracle of Our Lady's visit to St. Juan Diego and how she has left us her own image on St. Juan Diego's tilma. First we'll pray a rosary (bi-lengual) in the Church and then go downstairs for the talk. After the talk I have asked Amalia from across the street to bring some tamales and hot chocolate. As you know the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe is a very important Feast not only for those of Mexican descent but for everyone who lives in the Americas. When Our Lady appeared in 1531 there were basically no firm borders between the countries of the Americas and so she is Queen of all the Americas. Please feel welcome to come and share a little of the love we have as Catholics for our Mother and Queen.

On Thursday, December 15th the Women's Club will be having their annual Christmas Party. It will be held at Generations and will start with a social hour from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. followed by dinner. Reservations are required.
