

Dear Friends in Christ Jesus,

This Sunday is the sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time and also the World Day of the Sick. In a few days we will begin the season of Lent. Ash Wednesday is this coming Wednesday.

On Ash Wednesday we will have Mass and the distribution of ashes at 8:30 a.m. with the school children. And then at 11:00 a.m. there will be a Mass at St. John's with the distribution of ashes and finally another Mass at 6:30 p.m. at St. Sylvester's with the distribution of ashes. We begin Lent in a solemn manner on Ash Wednesday observing it as a day of fast and abstinence from meat. The fast for those 18 years old to 59 years old will consist of only one meal that day without meat. Two small snacks may be eaten as long as they do not equal another meal. Because of the Masses there will be no adoration on Ash Wednesday. Those who have reached their 14th birthday are also required to abstain from meat.

On every Friday of Lent there will be stations of the Cross following the morning School Mass and again each evening at 7:00 p.m. The Stations of the Cross will be held at St. Sylvester's Church both in the morning as well as in the evening. This rather ancient liturgical prayer is a good way to be reminded of the sacrifice of Christ and is a fitting way to enrich our Lenten observances. On the Fridays of Lent no meat may be eaten by those 14 years of age and older. Also on each Friday of Lent there will be fish dinners served in the gym of the school from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. The Knights of Columbus are providing this as part of their annual fund-raising. It is also a great opportunity to mingle with fellow parishioners and others. Please come out and support this effort.

Lent is a time of spiritual renewal for the whole parish. It is a time to be reconciled with God and with others. Lent is 40 days in length and culminates with a special week called Holy Week. During Holy Week the community is invited to come together to celebrate the Mass of the Last Supper on Holy Thursday and the beautiful and simple celebration of the Lord's passion on Good Friday. And then on Holy Saturday night we will celebrate the Easter Vigil with its readings from Holy Scripture, and special ceremony of candles. Lent is not complete without Holy Week. And of course Lent is a preparation for the greatest Liturgical Feast of the year, Easter. Let us strive to make this Lent a truly blessed time by our sacrifices, penances and prayers. If we do so we will arrive at Easter truly renewed in our holy faith and in our relationship with Almighty God.

God bless you and let us pray for each other.
