



Wednesday, November 1st FEAST OF ALL SAINTS. Obligatory Mass for the school at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester followed by a Rosary in the Cemetery of St. Sylvester for the Faithful Departed. Everyone welcome.

Wednesday evening at 5:30 p.m. Mass at St. John's for the FEAST OF ALL SAINTS. (obligatory)

Thursday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>. FEAST OF ALL SOULS: 8:30 a.m. Mass at St. Sylvester's for school. Mass at St. John's at 11:00 a.m. followed by Rosary in the cemetery of St. John's for Faithful Departed. Prison Mass at 2:00 p.m. in Caldwell. On this day a priest can say three Masses for the Faithful Departed.

Friday, November 3rd FIRST FRIDAY OF THE MONTH. No school Mass. 12:00 noon Rosary at St. Joseph's Burkhart in the cemetery. 7:00 p.m. First Friday Mass at St. Sylvester followed by a period of Eucharistic Adoration.

Saturday, November 4th FIRST SATURDAY OF THE MONTH. 8:30 a.m. Mass at St. Sylvester's followed by pot luck breakfast in Basement. 10:30 a.m. Rosary in St. Sylvester's cemetery in the new part at 10:30 a.m.

Sunday, November 5<sup>th</sup> Masses as usual and a rosary at old St. Patrick's cemetery in Wayne National Forest at around 12:45 p.m.

The other rosaries are listed on the hand-out that has been in the bulletin several times over the past few weeks.


