Happy New year to one and all!! May God bless you and your loved ones abundantly throughout the New Year.

I came across several quotes from holy people regarding the value of suffering. I thought it might be a good idea to include one of these quotes in each of my letters in the weekly bulletin. Here is the first one: "As iron is fashioned by fire and on the anvil, so in the fire of suffering and under the weight of trials, our souls receive that form which our Lord desires them to have." (St. Madeline Sophie Barat)

This Sunday I will go down to Gallipolis to see some of my family members and stay overnight. On Monday January 2<sup>nd</sup> I will offer the Mass at St. Louis church for my family and then have a little get together with some of my siblings. We rarely get together without the kids and grandkids so we'll see if this works. I will cancel the Mass on Monday at St. Sylvester's this week. The rest of the week's daily Masses will be offered as usual except for Wednesday. The adoration on Wednesday will be shortened due to the fact that I will be travelling to Marietta to participate in the annual priests' dinner that Bishop hosts at St. Mary's Basilica. Adoration will begin after the 8:30 a.m. Mass that I will offer at St. Sylvester's and will be closed at 2:00 p.m. And so there are two changes in the daily Mass schedule: No Mass on Monday and the Wednesday Mass will be offered at 8:30 a.m. followed by the adoration beginning at 9:00 a.m.

On Thursday, January 5<sup>th</sup> I will bless water with a special Epiphany Blessing at 4:00 p.m. The ceremony of blessing takes about 45 minutes and will be done at St. Sylvester's Church. It will be done in Latin. If anyone is interested in having water blessed that day please bring a container of water to set on the table in front of the first pew. Salt may also be brought to be blessed. The salt can be used then for cooking or for sprinkling around the house. Both blessings include exorcisms. The Feast of the Epiphany is celebrated in the traditional calendar on January 6<sup>th</sup> but in the new calendar it is moved to Sunday, January 8<sup>th</sup>.

School will resume on Wednesday, January 4<sup>th</sup> and the first school Mass will be on Friday, January 6<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 a.m. Since that is the First Friday we will also celebrate a Mass at 7:00 p.m. for those who would like to go in the evening. Following the 7:00 p.m. Mass there is a period of Eucharistic Adoration in company with the choirs of angels. Please feel free to attend if you wish.

On Saturday, January 7<sup>th</sup>, the First Saturday of January we will continue with our First Saturday devotions. There will be a rosary prayed in Latin at 7:30 a.m. followed by a period of meditation at 8:00 a.m. and then finally Mass at 8:30 a.m. and potluck afterwards in the basement of St. Sylvester's Church. All are welcome to attend. Our Lady promises us that if we observe the Five First Saturdays as she has requested we will receive the grace to die in sanctifying grace. Confessions will be heard starting at 7:30 a.m.

I hope everyone will have a good week as we begin 2023!!
