



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today on this 12th Sunday in Ordinary time I am only a week away from my retirement and my mind is filled with memories of my 39 years as an active priest, five of which have been spent here in Monroe County. Retiring of course for a priest doesn't mean that he is no longer a priest. It just means that he no longer administers a parish. I'll still be active in my priesthood as long as the Lord permits. When I go down to Greenville, South Carolina I'll be assisting the priests at my sister's parish and filling in for other priests in the Diocese of Charleston, S. Carolina who need some help. I look forward to living with my sister and her husband and getting to know better her 13 children and 40 grandchildren. But, at the same time I feel a sadness about leaving from Monroe County. It is a beautiful place here and I will miss the communities at St. John's and St. Sylvester's as well as the school community. It has been a wonderful five years of ministry here and the Lord has deepened my walk with Him. I admit that I was not always that good in preaching and I made changes in the Liturgy that upset some people. Please forgive me if I have hurt anyone. The last thing in the world that I wanted was to drive anyone away from the Church. I am hoping that Father Nick Ward's ministry will be effective in bringing back those who have left the parishes. Father Ward will be spending this coming week with me as we make the transition of pastoral leadership. He is very excited about coming here to minister and this will be his first time administering a parish.

On Monday, June 24th the Church celebrates the nativity of St. John the Baptist. It is a major Feast in the Church and since we have one of our parishes named after the Baptist we will have Mass at 5:30 p.m. at St. John the Baptist Church instead of at St. Sylvester's Church. We might even have some Pizza afterwards in the Hall. The rest of the week will have our normal schedule of Masses and Adoration. I'll be packing up the rest of my things and spending time with Father Ward to change over the signature on our back accounts and visiting the nursing homes and shut-ins. He'll be busy becoming familiar with the layout of the parishes and learning the schedule of Masses and all that goes into running a couple of parishes. Please keep him in prayer and also me as I make this transition to retirement. I'll be here this next weekend (June 29<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>) and will leave on July 1st.
