Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are already beginning February!! I hope you are all doing well. Our Mass schedule and adoration program are as usual. It looks to be a quiet week here in our parishes of Monroe County. Next week, however we will begin the great season of Lent. Ash Wednesday is next week and that day we have a school Mass at 8:30 a.m. with another Mass at 11:00 a.m. at St. John's. Then, there is also a Mass at 6:30 p.m. at St. Sylvester's for those who can not make the earlier Masses. There will be no adoration program next week on Wednesday.

On the Fridays of Lent we will have the 8:30 a.m. Mass for the school followed by Stations of the Cross. Then, each Friday evening, except for Good Friday the Knights of Columbus will serve a Fish Dinner beginning at 4:00 p.m. and going until 6:00 p.m. The Stations of the Cross will commence each Friday at 7:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's. I sure hope they will be better attended than they were last year. Stations of the Cross is a traditional Lenten devotion that helps us to realize how much Our Lord suffered for our redemption. The memory of His passions is a very strong feature of the Lenten period.

Of course during Lent those who are 14 years of age and older must abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and on each Friday as a penance that the Church places upon us as a community of sinners in need of salvation. Those who are between the ages of 18 and 59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday as well as abstain from eating meat. The fast consist of eating only one full meal and two small snacks that together do no equal another meal.

Lent is a time when we seek to be more completely reconciled with Almighty God. The Church points out to us that we are sinners in need of salvation. It is very important to make a good confession sometime during the forty days of Lent. Of course we might even go more than just one time during this season. For some, confession of sins is not practiced like it should be. I encourage everyone to go this Lent and if you are not sure how to do so please feel free to tell me when you come into the confessional and I will guide you through it. I think everyone should know by now that we must never receive Our Divine Master in the Sacrament of Holy Communion if we are aware that we have sinned mortally. And again if you are not sure if you have committed a mortal sin please talk to me about it in the Sacrament of Penance/Reconciliation.

I'll remind you again of these things next Sunday in the bulletin but you might already begin to decide on what additional penances and devotions you wish to pursue during the time of Lent. Certainly we must try to work on our vices and with the help of God overcome them.
