

Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend we begin the season of Advent, a period of waiting in expectation for the coming of the Lord. Christmas is not too far away but we have this special time to prepare our hearts for the Lord Jesus to be born again in us. So Advent like Lent is a penitential season and that is why we do not decorate the Church until close to Christmas. The priest wears purple during Advent signifying that this time is a time to do penance. We should try to mortify our appetites with some fasting and abstinence and spend more time in prayer and spiritual reading. Amidst the hustle and bustle that characterize this season we are to try to find time to be quiet and reflective and wait in patience for Christmas to arrive. This year Christmas falls on Monday, December 25th and so the fourth week of Advent will last only for a day because December 24th is on a Sunday and is the Sunday of the fourth week of Advent. But, that very evening at 5:00 p.m. we will celebrate the Christmas eve Mass at St. Sylvester's!! Our Masses for Christmas Day will be at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's and 10:30 a.m. at St. John's. Let us pray for each other as we begin this holy season of Advent that our hearts will be truly purified and made ready for the coming of the Lord.

Please take a look in this bulletin at the Masses for this week because we have a Holy Day of Obligation this week. The Holy Day is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It falls on Friday of this week. So our Masses for the Holy Day are as follows: Thursday, December 7<sup>th</sup> the Vigil Mass of the Immaculate Conception will be at 5:30 p.m. at St. Sylvester's. Then, on Friday, December 8<sup>th</sup> we will have a school Mass at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's and an evening Mass at 5:30 p.m. at St. John's. The other Masses during this week are as normal and adoration on Wednesday will be as usual as well.

We have had some extraordinary expenses lately. We bought new books for St. Sylvester's for over \$4,000.00. They will not need to be replaced again for many years. There is a hymnal as well as another volume for the readings. Also, at St. Sylvester's we are faced as you know with repairs on the boiler and that will costs several thousand dollars. At St. John's we put in a new security system and spent several thousand dollars as well. Before the New Year if any one would like to give either Church a special gift to help us out it would be greatly appreciated.

God bless each of you and may you find joy and peace in this season of Advent.
