Here we are at the end of August and ready for our school to get started. On August 30<sup>th</sup>, 1924 the Church of St. Sylvester was consecrated by the Bishop of Columbus. At that time we belonged to the Diocese of Columbus. To celebrate this yearly anniversary we will have a special Mass at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, August 30<sup>th</sup> at St. Sylvester's followed by a dinner in the basement of the Church. I hope you will attend if your schedule allows. It might be a good idea to call Jennifer Winkler or Edie Schumacher to let them know you plan to attend so that we can get an idea of how many people to prepare for at the dinner.

On that same evening (Monday, August 30<sup>th</sup>) we will also have an open house in the school from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. I'll be talking to the parents of the Catholic students at 7:00 p.m. in the Gym. School starts on Tuesday, August 31<sup>st</sup>. I hope we will have a safe and enjoyable school year. Please say a prayer that everything will go well. I'll be taking the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe to the school on Thursday morning, September 2<sup>nd</sup> and telling the amazing story of her apparition to St. Juan Diego.

This coming Friday will be the First Friday and our Mass at 8:30 a.m. will be attended by the kids at school. Of course it is open to everyone as well. At 3:00 p.m. we will have our monthly holy hour at St. John the Baptist Church and again everyone that can make it there at that hour is more than welcome!! Saturday, September 4<sup>th</sup> will be the First Saturday of September and so we will have our Latin Mass at 8:30 a.m. followed by a pot luck breakfast in the basement of the Church.

On Saturdays at 1:00 p.m. I have started a class for those who are interested in knowing more about Catholicism. Right now we have one person attending. We meet in the parish office area in the pre-school building next to the Church.

The Image of Our Lady of Guadalupe has been circulating around in our parish since August 13<sup>th</sup> but it will be taken to Caldwell by Father Morris this coming Friday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>. He will take it to his churches so that her beautiful and miraculous image can be venerated by the Catholic community there. It has been a true blessing that we have been able to have this replica of the image that hangs in the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City for these past few weeks. Each household that has received her image has been blessed by the Mother of God. We are sad to see her image depart but we are happy to share it with our fellow Catholics in the adjoining county. May she bring many blessings to those Catholic communities as well.
