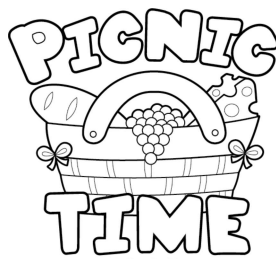

Dear Friends in Christ,

Please welcome Father Tim Shannon this weekend for the Masses. As you read this I am in Tulsa getting ready to drive back to Ohio. I am glad that my brother is with me to help with the driving because fourteen hours is more challenging to drive now than it used to be. I'm not as young as I used to be!! I hope everyone has had a good week and I look forward to being back in the parish by Tuesday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>. I'll plan to have the 5:30 p.m. Mass that day at St. Sylvester's. And on Wednesday we'll have the all day adoration again beginning at 8:00 a.m. and going until 6:00 p.m. Mass that day will be at 6:30 p.m. followed by the meeting of the Knights of Columbus.

This coming Friday and Saturday are the First Friday and First Saturday and so on Friday instead of doing the 3:00 p.m. Holy Hour of Reparation we will start with Mass at 7:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's and then have a period of adoration accompanying the angels of God and this will last until about 11:00 p.m. There is a book that the Brothers and Sisters of the Holy Family International left me when they came to visit us in June. It is called the Nine Offices and is meant to be prayed as a Vigil leading up to the First Saturday. It is rather penitential in nature and is a good prayer to pray as reparation for the sins committed against the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. If the Lord grants you the grace to accompany us I will be very pleased.

On the First Saturday our Latin Mass will be at 8:30 a.m. as usual and after the Mass we'll enjoy a time of socializing and eating some tasty breakfast foods as a potluck breakfast. We would love it if you came and participated fulfilling the request of Our Lady of Fatima to make five First Saturdays in reparation for the sins committed against her Immaculate Heart. The rosary will be prayed at 8:00 a.m. Our Lady also asked for confession and 15 minutes of meditation on one or more of the holy mysteries of the rosary. Please do everything possible to answer the request of the Mother of God in this regard. I usually have the Church opened by 7:15 a.m. on Saturdays so people can come in and spend some time in prayer and if anyone needs to go to confession please let me know during that time.
