We are now celebrating the third Sunday of Easter. There are seven Sundays of Easter all together. The season ends with the Feast of Pentecost. Speaking of Pentecost, please keep our Confirmation candidates in your prayers because in a little more than a week the Bishop will be confirming them. The date is May 2nd at the 5:00 p.m. Mass. These are the candidates: 1.) Sydney Lang, 2.) Jolie Christman, 3.) Carson Burkhart, 4.) Lizbyn Cole, 5.) Caden McLaughlin. I have been meeting with them for the past several months. It would be great to see the Church full for that Mass of Confirmation. In the Sacrament of Confirmation these candidates will receive the anointing of the Holy Spirit who will come upon them and fill their souls with His gifts. They will be strengthened in their witness to Jesus, the Son of God. Like the first apostles they will be given the graces they need to live courageously their holy faith and they will be sealed with an indelible mark on their souls. With the grace of Confirmation they will be offered the gift of Wisdom to discern more fully what God is calling them to do with their lives. Perhaps He is calling some to join Him in the religious life or the secular priesthood. We need to support these young people and one of the ways to do so would be to attend the Mass of Confirmation to show them that we are praying for them and are with them on their faith journey. Next year we'll have another class for those in fifth grade or above. Just let me know if your child is ready to take the class.

The week ahead looks rather ordinary in terms of our Mass and adoration schedule. Even though it is over a month away I would like to announce that as a response to the Bishop's program of Eucharistic revival we are planning to have an extended time of Eucharistic adoration in preparation for the Feast of Corpus Christi which falls this year on Sunday, June 11th. Adoration will begin on Friday, June 9th after the morning 8:30 a.m. Mass at St. Sylvester's. It will continue all day and night and even all day on Saturday up until right before the 5:00 p.m. Mass. After the 5:00 p.m. Mass we'll have a Eucharistic procession around the grounds stopping at four different altars along the route for a moment of prayer. I'll be putting out a sign up sheet with the hours of adoration and asking the school, Knights of Columbus, Women's Group from St. Sylvester's and the people of St. John's in Miltonsburg to prepare the four altars. I hope that everyone will participate in some way to show Our Blessed Lord how much we are grateful for the gift of the Holy Eucharist. I encourage everyone to also participate in the weekly Eucharistic Adoration that we do every Wednesday throughout the year. I am very thankful for those who faithfully come for their regular hour each week to adore the Lord Jesus Christ truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. May He reward you!!

Here is another quote from the book: JESUS OUR EUCHARISTIC LOVE by Fr. Stefano Manelli: "Wonderful are the saving effects which every Sacrifice of the Mass produces in the souls of those who participate. It obtains sorrow and pardon for sins. It lessens the temporal punishment due to sins. It weakens the influence of Satan and the untamed impulses of our flesh. It strengthens the bonds of our union in the Body of Christ. It protects us from danger and disaster. It shortens the punishment of Purgatory; and it obtains for us a higher degree of glory in Heaven. No human tongue said St. Lawrence Justinian, can enumerate the favors that trace back to the Sacrifice of the Mass." Here in our parish Mass is offered every day!! Have a good week.
