Dear Beloved of God,

Happy Easter to each and every one of you. May the Light of the Risen Christ shine on you and your family this holy day. He is risen, He is truly risen!!

During the rest of this week until next Sunday April 11th we are encouraged to pray the Novena of Divine Mercy at 3:00 p.m. Each day of the Novena is an opportunity to bring another group of souls to Our Merciful Savior and to praise His Divine Mercy. I put some brochures in the back of the Church with the prayers and intentions for each day. Feel free to take one home with you especially if you are not able to get to the Church for the 3:00 p.m. common recitation of the Novena. Next Sunday is the Feast of Divine Mercy and a very special day because Our Blessed Lord will pour forth His mercy in great abundance that day and grant us the complete forgiveness of sins and punishment due to those sins. The conditions for receiving this special grace are that we make a good confession and receive Holy Communion. The reception of these sacraments can be done within eight days before or after Divine Mercy Sunday. We must stay in a state of grace, however in order to receive the Eucharist worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday and thus obtain the promised forgiveness of all the punishment due to our sins.

On Divine Mercy Sunday April 11th at 3:00 p.m. we will have a Holy Hour and adore Our Eucharistic Lord while praying the Novena prayers as well as a rosary. I hope that everyone will join me.

After Divine Mercy Sunday I plan to go out to my former Diocese of Tulsa, Oklahoma and perform a Baptism as well as celebrate some special Masses. During my absence there will be no daily Masses here in Monroe County but the weekend that I am gone (April 17th-18th) there will be a priest from Toledo who will take the Masses and will speak about supporting the Food for the Poor Mission. It is a very worthwhile charity that I have been supporting for many years and I am sure some of you have as well. But until that time I will be here celebrating with you the Novena of Divine Mercy which ends on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 11th.

God bless and strengthen you as you rejoice in the Resurrection of the Son of God!!
