My dear Parishioners,

One hundred years ago, the Catholic Christians of Woodsfield Ohio built a truly beautiful church.

They purchased hand-chiseled marble altars from Italy. They commissioned the finest stained-glass windows from Bavaria in Germany. With sweat and hard labor, they quarried massive blocks of golden sandstone and hauled them by horse-drawn cart to the very place where we stand and worship the Living God even to this day, a full century later.

They surely spared no expense to erect this magnificent edifice. There are few churches in our diocese, let alone in Ohio, to compete with this gem of a church crafted by our ancestors, here in Woodsfield. In the middle of plain and simple Monroe County, where there are few things that glitter, we nonetheless have plenty of gold.

I don't just speak of the "gold" present in this lovely church building whose birthday we celebrate with such joy. I speak of that unsurpassable treasure which is even more precious: the treasure of our Catholic faith. Saint Peter says in the beginning of his first epistle: "In this you rejoice, although now for a little while you may have to suffer through various trials, so that the genuineness of your faith, more precious than gold that is perishable even though tested by fire, may prove to be for praise, glory, and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ (1 Peter 1:7)."

In a hundred years, we have had much to celebrate from so many weddings, baptisms, confirmations, first communions, graduations, holidays and homecomings celebrated here in this church. At the same time, we have had our fair share of difficulties and trials as well. We have suffered through hard times, endured great and difficult changes, and watched many of our friends and loved ones come and go.

All the while, we have had our faith in Jesus Christ to sustain us, nourish us, and guide us throughout the various joys and trials of this life. In this sacred temple, whose storied walls contain the memories and histories of our people, I hope that we can always remember that the stories of our lives begin and end with Jesus Christ, holding onto our faith as something that is of inestimable value, much like our cherished Saint Sylvester church.

On this most auspicious day, I pray that Almighty God imparts every grace and blessing upon this parish, that it may continue to enjoy the blessings of His divine providence, and I pray that our faith, more precious than gold, may guide us from these stone walls to the halls of heaven.
