Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday is the Fifth Sunday of Lent and as you see the statues are covered up. This covering of the statues is meant to evoke in us a sense of deprivation and signals that a change is occurring within the Lenten season itself. For the last part of Lent the Church bids us to reflect especially on the suffering and death of Our Lord. These last two weeks, if lived in the spirit of sorrow for our sins can bring us to appreciate even more the glorious event of the Resurrection. We pass through this valley of tears mourning the fact that we have so often neglected to obey and serve Jesus Christ. Instead we have given way to our selfish desires and prayed so seldom for mercy and peace. May the good Lord be kind to us and compassionate since we are so weak. May the gift of the Holy Spirit assist us to do better in the future and to love God and neighbor as we should. Then we too in union with Christ will rise to a new life in a glorious resurrection when it is our time to depart this world.

Palm Sunday

Next Sunday is Palm Sunday. We will have the 5:00 p.m. Saturday evening Mass as normal in St. Sylvester's Church. On Sunday, April 10th the schedule will be different, however. The Palm Sunday Liturgy will begin in the school gym at 9:00 a.m. We will celebrate the blessing of palms and the reading of the First Gospel. When the palms are blessed we will process out of the school building, up to the top of the cemetery and then down to the Church. Once inside the Church we will continue with the Liturgy of the Word and listen to the Gospel of the Passion. The Mass will then continue as usual. And so instead of having an 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's and then 10:30 a.m. Mass at St. John's we will have only the 9:00 a.m. Mass at St. Sylvester's starting in the gym of the school. If anyone is unable to join in the procession from the school to the Church he or she can simply wait for us in the Church. We will be there about 9:30 a.m.

Holy Week Schedule

Monday, April 11th ----- 5:30 p.m. Mass followed by Bible Study at St. Sylvester's

Tuesday, April 12th ------ 9:00 a.m Mass at St. John's. There will also be a 7:00 p.m. Mass at the Basilica of St. Mary's in Marietta. It will be the Mass of Chrism in which the whole Diocese is invited to participate. Bishop will bless the holy oils and will receive the renewal of our priestly promises. Please be there if possible.

Wednesday, April 13th ------ 8:30 a.m. School Mass followed by Eucharistic Adoration until 6:00 p.m. followed by Mass at 6:30 p.m. Adoration will start at 10:00 a.m.

Holy Thursday, April 14th ------ No morning Mass. Mass will be at 7:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's. The Mass will be the Mass of the Last Supper and the traditional foot washing will occur.

Holy Saturday, April 16^{th} ------ There is no morning Mass. The Vigil will begin at 8:30 p.m. at St. Sylvester's.

Easter Sunday, April 17th ----- Masses as usual.

Let's all make a concerted effort to be at all of the Holy Week Services. Please note that beginning on Good Friday and extending to the Sunday after Easter we will pray the Novena of Divine Mercy at 3:00 p.m. each day at St. Sylvester's. The Novena will end on Sunday, April 24th.
