Vespers

This Sunday, January 30th the Sisters of the Children of Mary will be visiting our parish community and will speak with us following Vespers and a Pot luck dinner. The Vespers are the evening prayer of the Church prayed throughout the world by Catholics. We will pray our Vespers at 5:00 p.m. and then go down to the basement of St. Sylvester's Church to enjoy a pot luck dinner with the Sisters. After the dinner the Sisters will speak to us. They are a new religious community in the Church and very much alive in the Spirit. I went to visit their "farm" in Newark, Ohio a couple of weeks ago. They also came to our parish and school last year. I invited them back this year as well. On Monday morning they will visit the school children and talk to them about the Catholic faith. They'll be staying overnight at Lance and Angie's place. Thanks Lance and Angie for your hospitality.

Mass on Monday

Because of the visit of the Sisters we will have our Monday Mass at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's and not at 5:30 p.m.

Bible Study

The Monday evening Bible Study will begin at 6:00 p.m. but there will be no Mass preceding it since I will have celebrated Mass in the morning at 8:30 a.m.

Catholic Schools' Week

This week is Catholic Schools' Week in the Diocese of Steubenville. On Monday, January 31st the Sisters of the Children of Mary will be visiting the classes. On Tuesday I have invited Father Josh Erickson, the Diocesan Vocation Director to come and speak to the children. And on Wednesday, Bishop Monforton will be visiting the school and celebrating the school Mass at 8:30 a.m. Because of the morning Mass the Adoration program will not begin until 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday and will continue until 6:00 p.m. as usual.

Candlemas Day: February 2nd Wednesday

This coming Wednesday is Candlemas Day, or the Day of the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple. Besides the morning Mass with the Bishop and the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament beginning at 11:00 a.m. there will be Benediction at 6:00 p.m. followed by the Mass at 6:30 p.m. The Knights of Columbus will be meeting after the Mass since it will be the first Wednesday of the month.

First Friday

The First Friday is this coming Friday and so as usual we will have a Holy Hour of reparation beginning at 3:00 p.m. at St.John the Baptist Church in Miltonsburg. The hour will consist of the Stations of the Cross and the Chaplet of Divine Mercy followed by exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and a short period of silent adoration followed by Benediction.

First Saturday

This coming Saturday is the First Saturday of the month and as usual we will have a Latin Traditional Mass at 8:30 a.m. followed by the blessing of candles. Afterwards there will be a potluck breakfast in the basement of St. Sylvester's Church.

Let us pray for the school apostolate that God will bless our efforts to catechize the children of our parish communities. Happy Catholic Schools' Week!!
