Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Here we are at the end of February already!! March will be starting on Tuesday. And Tuesday is "FAT TUESDAY" meaning it will be the day before the fasting and penances of Lent. It will also mark the end of Ordinary Time in the Liturgical Cycle. Ordinary Time will not return again until June 6th.

Wednesday is ASH WEDNESDAY which is, of course a day of fasting and abstaining from meat. Anyone who has reached at least their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday is obliged to abstain from eating meat on ASH WEDNESDAY and on all the Fridays of Lent. All those who are between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are obliged to fast on ASH WEDNESDAY and GOOD FRIDAY. One full meal is permitted and two other meals may be taken which, when combined are less than a full meal.

Of course every Friday is a day of Penance all throughout the year. It is customary to continue to abstain from eating meat as a constant reminder that we must do penance every Friday. During Lent it is obligatory, however that we abstain from eating meat.

On ASH WEDNESDAY we will have three Masses. At 8:30 a.m. the Mass will be at St. Sylvester's and will be a school Mass. Ashes will be distributed at the Mass. We will also have a Mass at noon at St. John the Baptist in Miltonsburg. Ashes will be distributed, of course. And finally we will have Mass at 6:30 p.m. at St. Sylvester's with the distribution of ashes.

We will also have adoration on Wednesday but it will begin at 10:00 a.m. instead of 8:00 a.m. due to the school Mass at 8:30 a.m.

This coming Friday will be the First Friday and Mass will be at 8:30 a.m. followed by STATIONS OF THE CROSS for the school community. At 3:00 p.m. we will have a Holy Hour of reparation at St. John the Baptist Church which will include the STATIONS OF THE CROSS. And from 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. the KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS will be selling fish dinners in the gym. At 7:00 p.m. there will be STATIONS OF THE CROSS at St. Sylvester's Church.

Saturday, March 5<sup>th</sup> will be the First Saturday and there will be a Latin Low Mass at 8:30 a.m. followed by a Pot Luck breakfast.

I hope that everyone is planning to make the most of the season of Lent. There are three pillars on which Lent is built: Prayer, Penance, and Almsgiving. Consider coming to daily Mass and praying the daily rosary. Consider also a penance that will strengthen your Christian life and renew you. And think of specific ways to be more charitable to those in need. Let us pray for each other during the Lenten season that our good resolutions may be fulfilled.


