

Dear Friends in Christ,

Here we are at the beginning of July already. The summer is going fast!! I hope everyone has a great time this Fourth of July which we will celebrate on Tuesday. I'll be going down to Gallipolis to be with my family after the 8:30 a.m. Mass on Monday, July 3rd. I'll stay overnight in Gallipolis and the next day, July 4th I'll offer Mass at the little chapel that my nephew Tim built. And so there will be no Mass in our parishes Tuesday because I won't be back in Woodsfield until later on the Fourth of July.

On Wednesday, July 5th we'll have the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament starting at 8:00 a.m. at St. Sylvester Church until 6:00 p.m. when there will be Benediction followed by a rosary and then Mass at 6:30 p.m. After Mass the Knights of Columbus will meet in the basement of the Church. Tony Schumacher will be directing the meeting as he begins his tenure as Grand Knight.

On Thursday, July 6th we'll have a Holy Hour from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. at St. John's followed by Mass at 9:00 a.m. I will also be offering Mass at the Prison in Caldwell at 2:00 p.m. that same day. It will be my first time to do so. Father Paul Hrezo was celebrating the Mass once a month but is taking on a new assignment at the Josephinum seminary in Columbus as spiritual director. He asked me to take over the ministry to the Hispanic population at the parish and I told him "yes". July 6th also marks six full years that I have been working in the Diocese of Steubenville. I arrived six years ago in Church Town and was there for two years before being transferred to Monroe County. How fast time has flown!!

On Friday, July 7th we will not have Mass at St. Sylvester's because I am travelling to Washington Court House to celebrate the wedding Mass of my brother. It is a three hour drive but I'll be back that same evening, God willing!!

This coming Saturday, July 8th, I won't have the 8:30 a.m. Mass because I'll be returning from Washington Court House. In the afternoon of Saturday I have to go to Pittsburgh to pick up a priest friend of mine from Brownsville, Texas. The confessions and Mass in the afternoon will be done by Father Chet. My friend Padre Juan Pablo arriving from Brownsville will go with me to the Priests' Conference to be held in Oglebay Park starting on Monday, July 10th and ending on Thursday, July 13th. It is an excellent Conference and I have gone for the last couple of years. I will celebrate Mass on Monday, July 10th at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's before leaving for the Conference.
