Dear Friends in Christ,

I hope you are doing well in your Lenten resolutions and entering deeply into this holy season of Lent. Our Mass schedule for this week will be as usual except for Monday, March 6th. Instead of Mass in the evening we will have it at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester's Church and we will not have the Bible Study that day. Adoration will occur on Wednesday as usual.

We received the DPSC Goals for 2023 and here they are: St. Sylvester's Goal is \$26,029.95 and St. John's Goal is \$13,711.14. It will take a lot of effort on everyone's part to reach the goals but I hope we can do it. We have been very generous in the past and I am sure that we will be again this year. Everyone who is registered should have received a letter from the Bishop and a request for help. There are additional envelopes in the vestibule of each of our churches. We'll keep you informed of how we are doing in the campaign as we go along.

I want to inform you that we have several children who will be receiving First Communion and others who will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. We also have four children who will be baptized, confirmed and receive First Communion at the Easter Vigil. The Church directs us to receive through all three Sacraments of Initiation those who have reached the age of reason. Here are the dates for these ceremonies:

First Communions for St. Sylvester School Children

March 16th at 6:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's Church basement we will have a parents' meeting for First Communion candidates. All five candidates attend St. Sylvester's School.

Practice for these candidates will take place on Friday, April 14th at 9:00 a.m. at the Church of St. Sylvester.

First Confessions will take place April 1st at 4:00 p.m. at the Church of St. Sylvester.

The First Communion Mass will be April 15th at 5:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester.

First Communion for one child from St. John's

Harrison's first confession will be on Saturday, May 20th at 4:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's Church.

His First Communion will be the next day at 10:30 a.m. at St. John's Church

Reception into the Church at Easter

We will have two children who will be received into the Church at Easter at the Easter Vigil Mass on April 8th at 8:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's Church.

Confirmation Mass

There will be four candidates who will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on Tuesday, May 2nd at 5:00 p.m. at St. Sylvester's Church. Bishop Monforton will be the celebrant. Rehearsal for the Sacrament will be on Monday, May 1st at 6:15 p.m. after the 5:30 p.m. Mass. Confessions will be heard for the candidates and their sponsors and parents.

Please pray for these young people as they make their final preparations for these Sacraments.

Please don't forget that this Friday, March 10th the Fish Fry will begin at 4:00 p.m. and Stations of the Cross will start at 6:00 p.m.
