

Dear Parishioners,

A few announcements:

First of all, this Monday (December 8th) is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.

<u>It is a Holy Day of Obligation for us</u>, as it is the patronal feast of the United States. Mass times on Monday are listed in the calendar sections of the bulletin.

Secondly, we will have school penance service Friday December 12th at 8:30 AM. Fr. Tom Nau will assist.

We will also have a penance service in the evening for both parishes at St. Sylvester at 7:00 PM the same evening. Frs. Gaydosik, Nelson, and Pabin will assist. If you have not been to confession in a while, please see this as an opportunity to do so.

Thirdly, things will be a bit chilly <u>in St. Sylvester</u> until we replace a drainage pipe in the basement that leads water away from the boiler. The boiler will still run, but at reduced capacity. In the meanwhile, we will run heat through the electric wall units.

I hope your Christmas preparations are going well, and that you are taking advantage of all that this season of Advent has to offer spiritually. I'm not just talking about reconciliation: this Advent season invites us to long for Christ's coming to us, and to reflect on the love which brought our Lord to us down from heaven.

This upcoming Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, far from arbitrary, demonstrates God's love in a profound way in the life of Mary. She who was so willing to cooperate with God's plan of redemption received this great prevenient grace, to be born free from original sin.

The gift of Mary's great grace, given to her so that she may be for us the Mother of God (and our mother as well), demonstrates the power of God's love and his grace which is greater than any stain of sin.

As Mary rejoiced to receive such a grace, may we rejoice also to be partakers in what Mary received: a pledge of hope for the human race, that although we began our existence in sin and disobedience, we may yet achieve the salvation that Mary's Son won for us.
