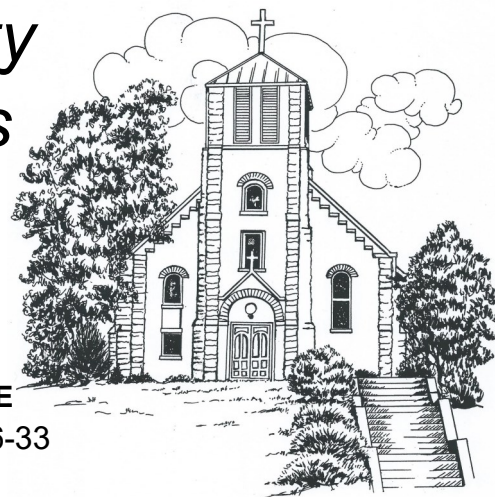

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

When you read this letter I will be in South Carolina in the Greenville area visiting my sister and her family. She is the mother of 13 children and 35 grandchildren and is a remarkable woman to be sure. I will return to Woodsfield late on Wednesday, June 28th. And so there will be no weekday Masses on Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday of this week. On Saturday evening and Sunday Father Martin Holler will be here to offer the Masses and will be speaking about UNBOUND, an organization that helps poor children get an education and assist the elderly in developing countries. I encourage you to consider “adopting” a poor child and helping with his or her education or “adopting” an elderly person who needs special help. I have been part of this organization for a number of years and can confidently recommend it to you.

On the great Feast of Sts. Peter and Paul (Thursday, June 29th) I'll offer the holy Sacrifice of the Mass at 9:00 a.m. at St. John's and I hope that many of you will come. It is a major Feast of the Catholic Church. On Friday, June 30th I'll have Mass at 8:30 a.m. at St. Sylvester and also on Saturday, July 1st. Our First Saturday Mass (July 1st) will be offered in Latin and English and is easy enough to follow. I would really encourage everyone to try to attend. We will pray the rosary at 7:30 a.m. followed by a guided meditation on some of the mysteries and then we will offer the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. All this will be done in a spirit of reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Our holy Mother. Following the Mass there will be a pot luck breakfast in the basement and everyone is more than welcome to attend even if you hadn't brought anything to share.

I look forward to seeing you all again. God bless and keep you safe from harm.
