

Saint Blaise was the bishop of Sebaste in Armenia during the fourth century. Very little is

known about his life. According to various accounts he was a physician before becoming a bishop. His cult spread throughout the entire Church in the Middle Ages because he was reputed to have miraculously cured a little boy who nearly died because of a fishbone in his throat. From the eighth century he has been invoked on behalf of the sick, especially those afflicted with illnesses of the throat.

Dear Friends in Christ,

Here we are already at the last Sunday of the month of January. I hope the New Year is going well for everyone. This week we celebrate National Catholic Schools' Week. It is a time to rejoice in the apostolate of Catholic education and all that results from it. Certainly those who fully participate in Catholic education experience lifelong effects that help to guide them through all the ups and downs of life. I am personally thankful that our communities are so strongly supportive of our little school. Some of you are making the nine First Fridays and hoping that Jesus will remember you in a special way at the hour of your death for having made reparation to His Sacred Heart. And of course, this Saturday is the First Saturday so we will have the rosary at 7:30 a.m. followed by a period of meditation and then by Mass at 8:30 a.m. Following Mass we will have a pot luck breakfast. Please come and join us if your schedule allows.

God bless and keep each of you and your families. May peace reign in our homes and throughout the whole world!!
