



Enkindle in them the fire of Thy love. Send forth Thy Spirit and they shall be created and Thou shalt renew the face of the Earth!!

Happy Memorial Day weekend. Thanks be to God for the generous service of those who have fought to keep our country free. May their memory ever remain.

These last days of May have a couple of important Marian Feasts. On Monday, May 29th, the Church celebrates the Feast of Mary, Mother of the Church. And on Wednesday, May 31st the Church celebrates the Feast of the Visitation of Mary to her cousin Elizabeth. I hope that you can come to Church those days and celebrate during the closing days of the Marian month of May these two great feasts of our holy Mother. May 31st is an important Feast for me personally because on May 31st, 1985 in Tulsa, Oklahoma I was ordained a priest of the Diocese of Tulsa. These 38 years have been blessed years for sure. If you remember say a prayer for me on Wednesday, May 31st.

So you see the week is full of wonderful Feasts and opportunities to put our faith into practice beyond the Sunday obligation. It does my heart good to see you at our daily Masses. I would love it if everyone came but I know that is not feasible. At any rate, please honor the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary this coming weekend and keep in mind throughout the month of June the love Jesus shows us through His Sacred Heart.

Please don't forget to sign up for an hour of adoration sometime on Friday, June 9th during the day or night and also on Saturday, June 10th as we prepare for the great Feast of Corpus Christi on June 11th. Remember too that after the 5:00 p.m. Saturday evening Mass on June 10th we will have a Eucharistic Procession involving the Knights of Columbus, the First Communicants and Confirmation students of this year, the Women's Group and the School community and everyone else. I would like everyone to process after our Eucharistic Lord in joy and thanksgiving for the tremendous Gift of the Holy Eucharist.
