

# ENGLISH TRANSLATION OF THE EASTER SEQUENCE "VICTIMAE PASCHALI LAUDES"

Let Christians offer sacrificial praises to the Passover victim. The lamb has redeemed the sheep:

The Innocent Christ has reconciled the sinners to the Father.

Death and life contended in a spectacular battle: the dead Prince of Life reigns alive.

Tell us, Mary, what did you see on the way?

"I saw the tomb of the living Christ and the glory of his rising,

The angelic witnesses, the shroud, and the clothes."

"Christ my hope is arisen; he will go before his own into Galilee."

More to be believed is truthful Mary by herself than the whole deceitful crowd of the Jews!

 $We \ know \ Christ \ is \ truly \ risen \ from \ the \ dead! \ On \ us, \ O \ Conqueror \ King, \ have \ mercy!$ 

Amen. Alleluia!

My brothers and sisters in Christ,

On this Sunday of Divine Mercy we rejoice because our God chose to reconcile sinners to Himself through the Cross of Christ.

The words of the *Exultet* come readily to mind: "O wonder of your humble care for us! O love, O charity beyond telling! To ransom a slave, you gave away your son."

The mercy that Jesus offers comes at the cost of His own life. It is not something that we receive in vain. It is not something that we should regard as cheaply bought or easily achieved. It was not easy to achieve our salvation. And for us, it takes a lot more than just having the right last name, or being a member of the right Church, or belonging to the right nation or tribe, or just by virtue of being a member of the right species (all dogs may go to heaven, but the same can't be said for us humans).

The mercy of God is extended to us not because we have any right to it by mere virtue of our existence, but only because we seek it with a contrite heart, a heart that loves God and seeks to be closer to Him; a heart that exclaims "Have mercy on me O God in your kindness (psalm 51)" or "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of David, have mercy on me! (Luke 18:38)."

O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty yourself out upon us, and increase your mercy within us, that we might seek all the more your mercy, and extend mercy to others as well.
